Thank you for proposing motion 8E, on behalf of Corfe Castle Parish Council, at the DAPTC online AGM on Saturday 19 November 2022.

Wording of Finalised Motion:

That DAPTC support the provisions in the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill to discourage the growth in second homes by a 100% surcharge on council tax and seeks further discretionary controls on the growth in holiday lets and if passed a resolution be forwarded to NALC, the Local Government Association and Dorset MP's

Agreed Resulting Action:

DAPTC to write to NALC, the Local Government Association and Dorset MPs in support of the motion.

Progress Update:

28/11/2022 - motion submitted to NALC for possible discussion at the next NALC Policy Committee meeting

1/12/2022 – the following response was received from NALC:

This is already NALC policy – no need for this to be considered at 24 January 2023 Policy Committee session - "Local councils to be empowered through legislation to levy a 'consequence tax' on second homes."

13/12/22 - DAPTC are writing to the Local Government Association and Dorset MPs – copies of the letters will be available in due course.

The DAPTC AGM webpage will be updated with this information.

Conclusion

- This is already NALC policy, but having this on record will help NALC strengthen any further debates on this matter, should they occur in the future.
- DAPTC are writing to the Local Government Association and to Dorset MPs – copies of the letters, and any subsequent responses, will be available in due course.
