

Reports on the Mar 2023

Clean up Corfe / Litter Free Purbeck Litter Picking in Corfe Castle Parish

Saturday 4th March 2023 Clean Up Corfe 9am - 3 Volunteers

- Litter picking completed around the Square, down to the A351 bridge, Station Road, along West Street, Webber's Close and the car park, through the play area , along East Street back to The Square and around the church.
- One large and 2 small bags of litter were collected.
- Generally the village was pretty clean, with most things collected being smaller items of waste.
- The most common item of litter picked up was cigarette butts.

Saturday 4th March 2023 Clean Up Corfe 9am – 3 + 1 Volunteers

- Litter picking completed around the Square, down to the A351 bridge, Station Road, down Olly Vyes Lanes and along both sides of the Church Knowle road to the A351 junction, along West Street, Webber's Close and the car park, and around the church.
- Later another volunteer was going to pick from halfway along East Street to the junction with the B3069.
- Three medium bags of litter were collected, plus the East Street waste.
- Generally the village was pretty clean, with most things collected being smaller items of waste.
- As usual the most common item of litter picked up was cigarette butts, and the most unusual a hearing aid! This was handed to a member of Swanage Railway staff as it was found by the station.
- The most litter was picked along Olly Vyes Lane and the Church Knowle Road.
