

Hygiene Services for the West Street Toilet Block.

Baby Changing:

At present Corfe Castle Parish Council, provide baby changing facilities in all three of its toilet areas, Ladies, Gents & Disabled, however we do not provide anywhere to put the dirty nappies. In the Ladies' & Disabled sections of the toilet block this is not too much of an issue as there are sanitary bins provided although the lids do not open up very far and therefore sometimes some nappies do not fit. However, in the Gents area of the toilet block we have no facilities at all for dirty nappies.

A few statistics:

- There are 19.2 million families in the UK
 - 15% are lone parent families &
 - 1.1% are same sex families.

Male incontinence:

A recent report, Binning the taboo: disposing with dignity, reveals that more than half (51%) of the men surveyed, of all ages, have experienced symptoms associated with urinary incontinence. This is leaving nearly 8 in 10 men anxious to leave the house.

Co-authored by Prostate Cancer UK and PHS Group, it highlights how the new figures vastly exceed previous estimates about the prevalence of urinary incontinence, which is an under-researched problem.

At present it is not law to supply Male Incontinence Bins in public toilets but is that a good enough reason not to?

The Chairman and Vice Chairman would like to recommend 1 x male incontinence bin in one cubicle saving between £70 - £104 per annum instead of recommendation 4 below.

Recommendation:

1. To supply 1 x sanitary bin in each ladies cubical (x3)
2. To supply 1 x nappy bin in the main ladies area by the nappy changing facilities
3. To supply 1 x nappy bin in the disabled area
4. *To supply 1 x male incontinence bin in each of the gents cubicles*
5. To supply 1 x nappy bin in the main gents area by the nappy changing facilities.
6. Add a section on our website showing / listing our toilet facilities
7. Change the signage on the exterior of the building to indicate baby changing facilities available.
Approx £2.50 per additional sign
8. Have the baby changing table in the disabled toilet area lowered so that wheelchair users can use the baby changing facilities.
