1. Email received by Clerk 4th April –

“I am writing on behalf of Corfe Castle Evangelical Congregational Church, regarding car parking.

We had permission to park in the Primary School car park for many, many years, longer than I can ever remember, but around Christmas time, I understand that the school had been taken over by a company who seem to have much stricter rules and we are not able to use it anymore. We are just wondering if you could help us here... Is it possible to have some allocated spaces for our church?

As you know parking is very difficult in Corfe Castle as it's so restricted.

Since Christmas we have been really struggling, our services including preparation and refreshments run from 2.30pm - 5.30pm on Sunday afternoons. We are also hoping to meet on a Saturday morning starting at some time in June.

A number of us have had to park in the public car park, past the Doctors Surgery at a cost of £4 each which not everyone can afford to do. Our fear is that because of this charge some may not turn up at all. Unfortunately parking on West Street is only for 1 hour, had it been 2 hours it might have solved our problem.

As you can see Michelle, we are struggling and each time we open for worship it is a worry for all the leaders of the church as they can't always find parking spaces and so end up having to pay £4 to park
