

Sanitary Waste

Last month it was agreed "To replace all sanitary bins within the Ladies toilet area and replace with incontinence bins. (1 per cubical)."

It has since come to light that the Male Incontinence bins have stickers attached to them, which may make them inappropriate for the ladies' toilets.

It is not possible to remove the stickers, as the bins are removed from site to be emptied and new bins left.

Recommendation:

1. Within the ladies' toilets, keep current sanitary waste bins, one per cubicle, plus one nappy waste bin by the changing table.
2. Within the disabled toilet, to have one male incontinence bin.
3. Within the men's toilets, to have one male incontinence bin in one of the cubicles, plus to have one nappy waste bin by the changing table.

N.B. Cost would be £565.60 per annum. Initial cost increase incurred in FY 23/24 will be covered by general contingencies.
