West Street Car Park Reserved Parking permit Conditions of Use

This information is designed to inform you of the terms and conditions for the Resident Parking scheme in the Corfe Castle Parish Council West Street Car Park. Should you need any further information please contact the Clerk via email clerk@corfecastleparishcouncil.gov.uk

Condition of Use

- Permits MUST be clearly displayed in the windscreen of a vehicle. Should the permit not be on display you risk being issued with a Penalty Charge Notice, from Dorset Council. Corfe Castle Parish Council cannot help having a parking ticket withdrawn.
- Corfe Castle Parish Council Parking Permits can be shared between multiply vehicles and registrations numbers do not have to be shared with the Parish Council.
- Vehicles using the reserved spaces must be of roadworthy condition, have a valid MOT and be insured.
- No vans, motorhomes, caravans or lorries are to be parked in the car park.
- Parking permits are not transferable to other parking place and the PC reserves the right to move spaces annually.
- Permits are issued for the whole of the financial year.
- Refunds may be considered and will be subject to an administration fee. Two months' notice is required (should the space be filled immediately the PC may waiver this timescale) and the sum refunded will be pro-rata to the end of the financial year, only full months will be refunded.
- If you apply for or use a permit fraudulently, the permit will be cancelled immediately with no refund. Corfe Castle Parish Council reserve the right to revoke a permit, if the conditions are not adhered to.
- If you misuse or allow your permit to be misused the Parish Council may cancel the permit.
- You are completely responsible for your car and contents when parked in the car park.

Fees

Fees for the 2023/24 financial year are as follows: **(amounts to be confirmed during budget setting)**

Residents £375 + VAT (Gross £450)

Non-residents/holiday homes £625 + VAT (Gross £750)

Second / replacement permit £20 + VAT (Gross £24)

Residents are defined as a person who lives within the Parish of Corfe Castle permanently or on a long-term basis (minimum 5 nights a week). Please notify Corfe Castle Parish Council as soon as residency status changes. Corfe Castle Parish Council reserve the right to review your charge and your entitlement to a permit.

Renewal

Corfe Castle Parish Council cannot guarantee automatic renewal of a permit at the end of the year. However, priory renewal will be given to the current permit holder.

Data Protection

Corfe Castle Parish Council will use all data provided within the application purely for the intention of issuing a permit. All processing of this data will be in accordance with the UK Data Protection Act 1998. No details will be shared with third parties.
