Hi All,

I have just had a call from Heather Penton of 32 East Street (verbal permission granted to publish personal details) in regard to the no mow area. She has specifically asked I let all councillors know she is not happy with the proposed plan for the playground area. She stated that her property is unique in that the only access is via the rear of the property and therefore any building works etc which is required, contractors much approach via the playing field (with landowners permission). At first Mrs Penton thought that there would be a hedge planted down the Eastern side of the field, however I did explain this was only a no mow area and not an area proposed for a hedgerow.

Mrs Penton stated to her knowledge the sewage pipes for these properties run north to south along the eastern boundary, but also possibly east to west across the field at a certain point, however she was unable to give the specific point.

Mrs Penton mentioned that the Halves was left and not mowed and therefore in her opinion this would make a better site to introduce wildflowers, rather than a strip of land on the playing fields.

Mrs Penton stated she may attend our next meeting along with writing in personally with the above.
