1. Email received from Robert stoner – School Acting Head Teacher. – Annex G
“The school is looking to apply to become a warm space for January-March on Sundays 10-3.
The current need:

Proposal to turn the bus shelter outside school into a pantry / sharing shed as a joint project with the Parish council.

Recommendation: CCPC form a working group to work along side the school to convert the old bus shelter outside school into a Pantry / Sharing Shed. The Clerk / Working Group work alongside the school to compile an estimate for building costs, and once funding has been sourced to apply for any planning permission required.
