

FEASIBILITY STUDY – KINGSTON HILL PATH

There was an old footpath leading from Lynch Farmhouse to the east side of the old church at Kingston. It fell into disuse after 1961. At present one of the fields is used for camping and it is uncertain how the current owner would welcome a re-instated footpath across the land. If the owner agreed, the footpath could be re-instated. It would not be used regularly. The owner has not been approached at present.

Lynch farmhouse itself has access to footpath 52 from their new driveway once they've crossed the B3069 (Kingston Hill road).
