

Douglas Charles Mundy
Age 20

Douglas Charles was born in the early part of 1924 at Corfe Castle, to Gordon Stephen Mattingly Mundy and Dorothy Rose Mundy. They were living at West St in Corfe Castle.

Gordon, Douglas' father had been born at Oxford and had served in the Royal Navy from June 1915 until May 1928, again from June 1930 until being "demobd" in 1938. He was then re-enlisted in November 1939 for six years. In September 1939 Gordon and Dorothy were living in West Street, Corfe Castle. Gordon was a cordite worker.

Gordon S M Mundy aged 26 and Dorothy R Whittle aged 23 were married at Corfe Castle in January 1923. Douglas was their only child.

Gordon died in April 1970, and Dorothy died in 1976.

Douglas would have been 18 in early 1942, when he would have been conscripted.

The Western Gazette carried a notice of death:- Mundy, August 10th the Cornelia Hospital, Poole. Douglas Charles, aged 20 years, only son of Mr and Mrs Gordon Mundy of Corfe Castle, Dorset, after a long and suffering illness patiently borne – From his loving Dad, Mum and Gran, Aunts, Uncles Cousins and all kind friends. "Safe Home"

Douglas Charles Mundy was buried at Corfe Castle on 15th August 1944 aged 20.

Douglas is not listed on the Commonwealth War Graves Commission website.
