Right to place a memorial

Headstone not exceeding 4' (122cm) in height	£220	£440

Note: The right to place a memorial fees do not include the physical memorial or the installation. Please discuss this with the stonemason.

Administration fees are £65 for a standard interment or for items such as Statutory declaration.

Definitions of Resident and Non-resident:

Resident: the deceased was a resident of Corfe Castle parish. Was born within Purbeck, had lived in Purbeck but moved away, still has close family residing within Purbeck. Purbeck is defined by the designated boundaries of the former Purbeck District Council.

Non-resident: no ties with the parish whatsoever

Reservations:

Over the years, reservation fees have been paid to secure a burial or cremation plot. Where the fee paid *more recently* closely reflects the full cost of burial at the time, there will be no additional charge in terms of burial or interment of cremated remains. However, if the reservation was made a significant time ago, before the year 2000, it may be necessary to charge the current burial rate, less the payment made at the time of reservation. Please contact the clerk to discuss this if necessary.

The income from fees is used for the maintenance of the cemetery. All fees to be paid to the Parish Council of Corfe Castle. Bank sort code 30.99.12 and account number 00289201

Reservation fee*

Reservations may be currently permitted in certain circumstances, for example, those wishing to reserve a burial plot next to a loved one, where space is available.

At the time of reservation you will be asked to pay the appropriate Exclusive Rights fee.

Please see the Regulations of God's Acre Burial Ground, before book an interment.
